

The Vermont Department of Motor Vehicles will begin implementing a new photo license system in December 2003.. This new system will result in a design change for our PHOTO licenses and Non-Driver Identification cards. The system changeover will be phased in, with all DMV offices estimated to be issuing the new identification documents by December 19<sup>th</sup>.

**A list of changes and additions follow:**

**NO CHANGE TO THESE FEATURES:**

**MAGNETIC STRIPE:** located on the back of all license, non-driver identification and employee identification cards and encoded with: Name, DOB, Height, Weight

**License and ID Types** will continue with the same types and under 21 text

**NEW/CHANGED**

- The overall look and format of all licenses/permits/identification cards has changed to a more durable and secure credit card style.
- Verbiage for under 18.
  - ◆ The under 18 Non-Driver Identification Card and Junior Operator License will contain text in red “UNDER 18 UNTIL MM-DD-YYYY”
- Vertical format Licenses and Non-Driver Identification Cards for MINORS
  - ◆ All Operator Licenses, Commercial Licenses, Permits and Non-Driver Identification Cards for individuals under 21 will be in a Vertical format.
- Only the individual applicable Class, Endorsement and Restriction information will be printed on the back of cards.
- Class 1 will now appear as Class D (non-CDL class) which is the correct AAMVA reference and will coincide with CDL classes A, B and C.
- Bar Code – AAMVA minimum requirements.
- Security Features - several additional covert and overt features
- Duplicate License and Id Card indication
  - ◆ “DUP” will appear in red upper right on duplicate licenses and identification cards.
- Storage of images and signatures etc.

- NOTES:**
1. Current styles will remain valid until renewed or the applicant obtains a duplicate.
  2. Learner Permits can be either vertical or horizontal orientation.
  3. Commercial Licenses/Permits can be either vertical or horizontal orientation.
  4. A Non-Driver ID for a person younger than 21, but older than 18 will have a “plum” bar.

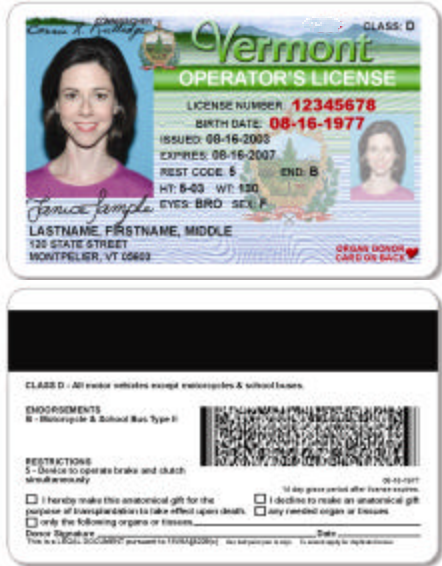
